"Minor service or maintenance work" means a project of public works that is limited to: (a) minor crack filling, chip or slurry sealing, or other minor pavement patching, not including overlays, that has a projected life span of no longer than 5 years or that is performed for a town and is not funded under s. 86.31, Stats. (i.e., TRIP projects), regardless of projected life span; (b) the depositing of gravel on an existing gravel road applied solely to maintain the road; (c) road shoulder maintenance; (d) cleaning of drainage or sewer ditches or structures; (e) or any other limited, minor work on public facilities or equipment that is routinely performed to prevent breakdown or deterioration.
2. This is a project for the erection, construction, repair, remodeling, or demolition of a residential property containing two dwelling units or less.
3. This is a road, street, bridge, sanitary sewer, or water main project that is a part of a development in which at least 90% of the lots contain or will contain two dwelling units or less, as determined by the local governmental unit at the time of approval of the development and that on completion will be acquired by or dedicated to a local governmental unit (including under Sec. 236.13(2), Stats.) or to the state, for ownership or maintenance.
4. This is a single-trade project with a total estimated cost less than \$48,000.
5. This is a multiple-trade project with a total estimated cost less than \$100,000.
6. This is a multiple-trade project with a total estimated cost less than \$234,000 that will be let to a private contractor and that is owned by (1) a city or village with a population less than 2500, or (2) a town.
